From Vallejo:

Merge onto I-80 W toward San Francisco. Take I-580 E toward Downtown Oakland. Merge onto I-980 W toward Downtown Oakland. Take the I-880 S exit. Take Jackson St exit. Turn left to take the I-880 N toward I-980 E/San Francisco. Take the Broadway ramp. Take the ramp toward Jack London Square. Turn left on Broadway. Make a U-turn onto Broadway. 2 Broadway is on the right.

From Fremont:

Merge onto I-880 N toward Oakland. Take the Broadway exit toward downtown Oakland. Take the ramp toward Jack London Square. Turn left onto Broadway. Make a U-turn onto Broadway. 2 Broadway is on the right.

From San Francisco:

Take I-80 E toward Bay Bridge/Oakland. Merge onto I-880 S via exit 8a toward Alameda/Airport/San Jose. Take the exit toward Broadway/Alameda. Turn right onto 5th St. Take the I-880 S ramp toward San Jose. Take the ramp toward Broadway/Alameda. Stay straight to go onto 5th St. Turn right onto Broadway. Make a U-turn onto Broadway. 2 Broadway is on the right.
